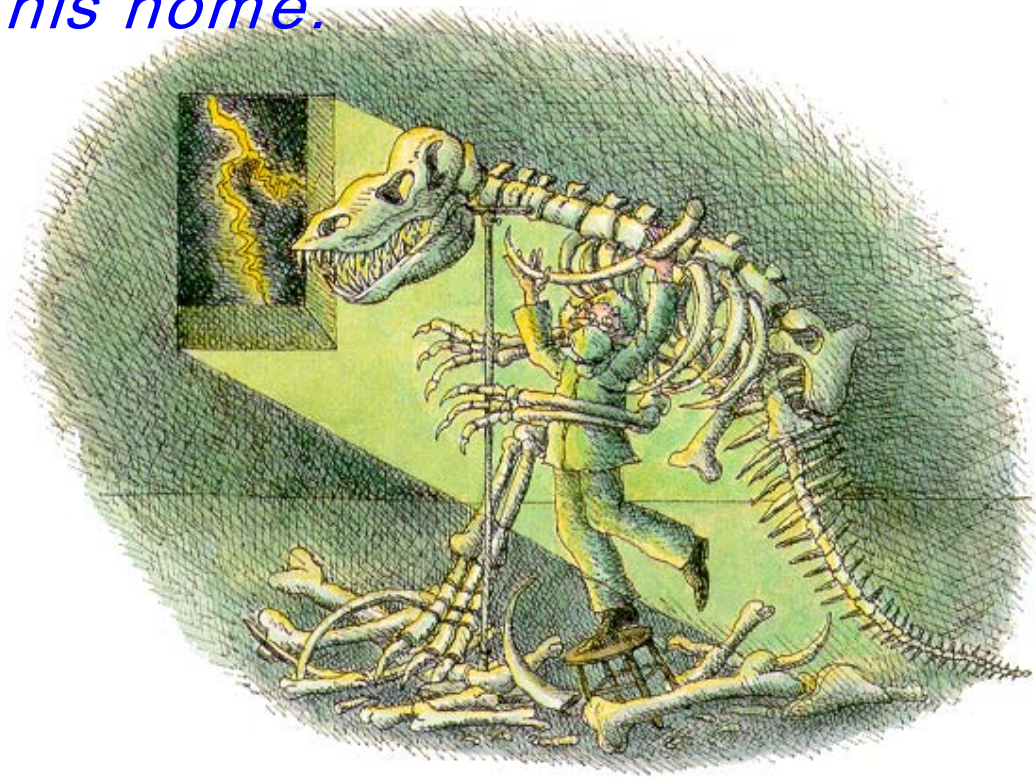
**Which one is a foot? A hand?**

bones.*



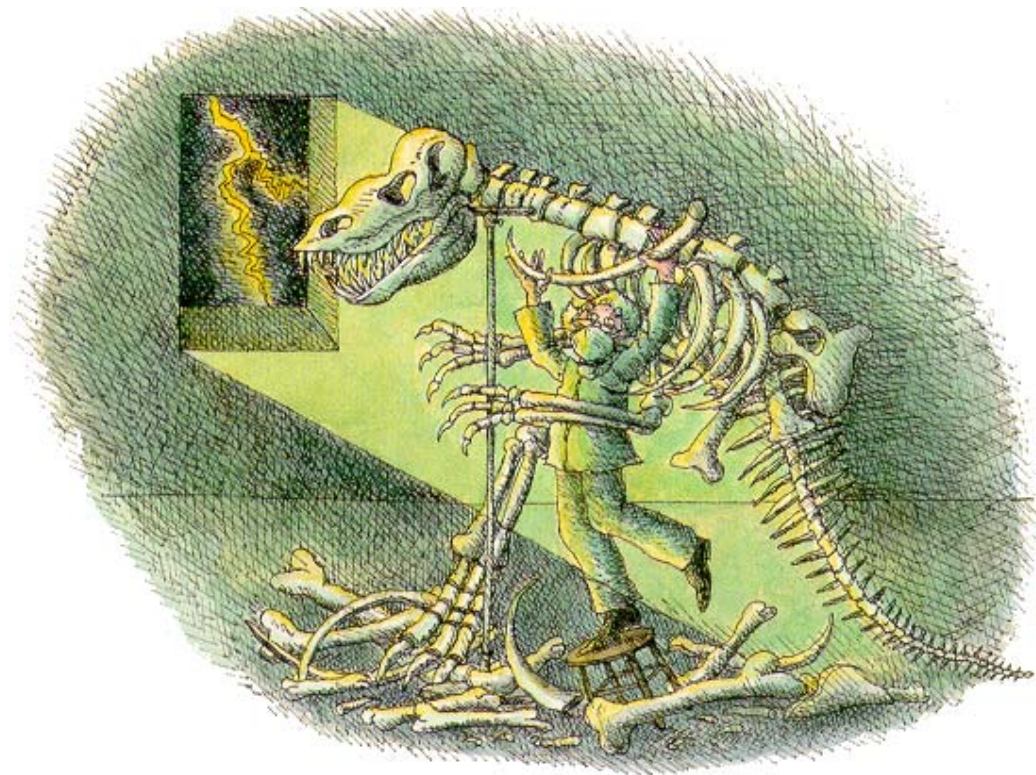


*Bones, bones, a million bones,
