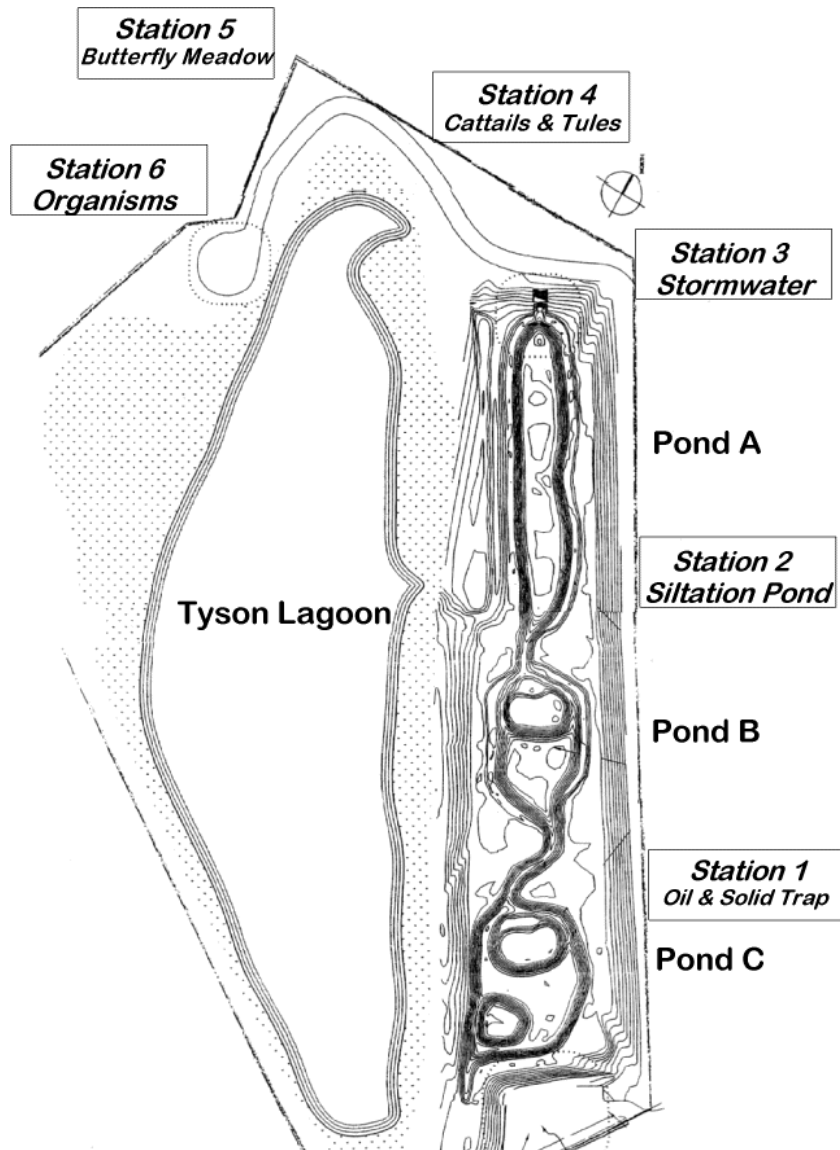


Exploring wetlands

1. Water (surface or ground)
2. Wetland soil (formed with water called hydric)
